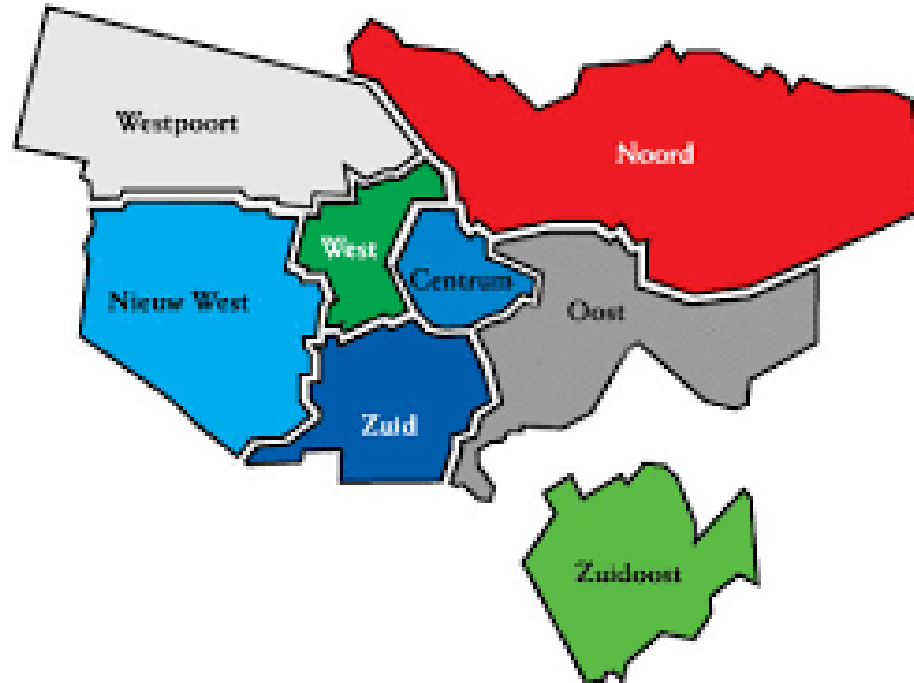

Responsibilities City of Amsterdam: youth

- Empowerment of the youth and their social environment
- To offer the right tailor-made support
- To strengthen a safe and supportive climate in families, neighborhoods and schools.
- For care, support and probation services



Responsibilities City of Amsterdam: adults I

- Strengthen the self-sustainability and participation of vulnerable inhabitants
- Job placement and income support
- Tailor-made individual support
- Fight domestic violence
- Protected living



Responsibilities City of Amsterdam: adults II

- Promotion of informal care and volunteer work
- Make the neighborhoods safe and livable
- Make houses, services and buildings accessible socially and physically
- Make use of experience experts
- Participation of clients and their family

- Welfare services: for youth and adults
- Make local services social accessible
- Make use of experience experts
- Social cohesion in the neighborhoods
