8 principles of IPS

IPS is a model of supported employment, developed in the US, for people with a serious mental illness.

- Focus on competitive employment
- 2. Open to anyone who wants to work: zero exclusion
- 3. Integration of rehabilitation and mental health services
- 4. Attention to worker preferences
- Personalized benefits counseling
- 6. Rapid job search
- 7. Systematic job development
- 8. Unlimited service and Individualized support. (in the Netherlands 2 or 3 years)



Status quo IPS at GGZ Ingeest

- In 2014 IPS started in 2 teams.
- Currently IPS is integrated in all F-ACT teams
- 13 IPS coaches work at GGZ Ingeest.
- 180 people take part of the IPS programme.
- Of which 40 are in the intake (first phase).
- And the other 140 candidates are in the matching procedure, or are employed. (43% is employed!)
- The IPS team meets weekly to exchange information, share successes and discuss cases.



Financing

IPS has its own budget and is financed by the UWV* or municipalities:

- 90 UWV* programmes
- 30 programmes by the local government of Amsterdam/ 15 other municipalities

The UWV IPS is financed for 3 years.

The local government IPS is financed for 2 years. (If needed, the local government provides jobcoaching after 2 years of IPS)

* UWV: Employee Insurance Agency



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Structure of IPS

- 1. Intake
- 2. Assessment, mediation, Active coöperation
- 3. Placement
- 4. Support

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Coöperation with partners

- Servicedesk for employers
- UWV: IPS specialist
- Benefits counselor
- Employment agencies
- Local employers network



Challenges

- Example: If a client is employed part-time and is on welfare, the financial benefits are minimal.
- The IPS programme is temporary, only for 2 or 3 years. This is not consistent with the F-ACT programme.



Succes of IPS

- IPS Individual Placement and Support is very successful. –:
- People in IPS attain employment faster, hold their jobs for longer, and work more hours. In 4 randomized controlled trials, over an 18-month period, approximately 3 times as many people receiving IPS services achieved employment and worked more hours, and people receiving IPS services worked overall four times as many hours compared to controls.
- IPS is more effective than alternative vocational approaches regardless of a variety of client background factors (e.g., ethnicity, gender, socioeconomic status).
