Letter of support from host institution, Mental Health Centre Copenhagen (MHCC)

I hereby confirm that the MHCC is prepared to host the project "Developing an intervention to promote recovery for patients with depression after transference to primary healthcare", and that the workplace can provide the necessary office facilities during the full length of the project.

MHCC fully support the project which develops a complex intervention to promote recovery and prevent relapse and readmission of adults with unipolar MDD when transferring from the secondary to the primary healthcare sector. The intervention will be developed through a codesign process with stakeholders. This involves patients, GPs, mental- and social healthcare professionals.

The project is an intersectoral collaboration between 1) MHCC, 2) Mental Health Centre Ballerup, 3) Centre for Social Medicine at Frederiksberg Hospital and 4) Centre for Research and Education in General Practice at the University of Copenhagen.

We believe the study may improve the future treatment in patients' sector-transition when discharged from psychiatric outpatient clinics to the primary healthcare sector.
